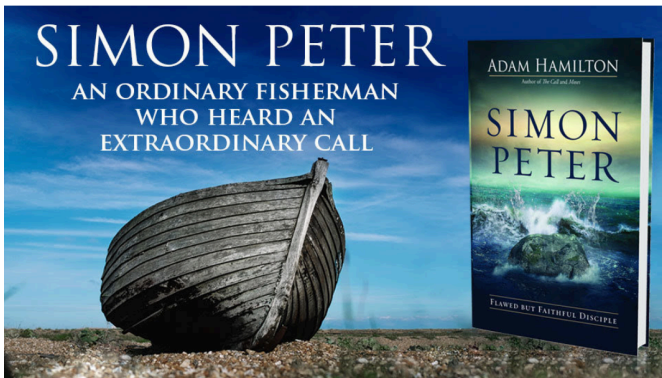


Embark on a Transformational Journey with "Simon Peter: A Flawed but Faithful Disciple"
